








Proposed 5-Lane Section with Center Turn Lane North of Krif Road




Proposed Median Divided 4-Lane Section North of Krif Road











Proposed Median Divided 4-Lane Section North of Krif Road













Middle – Roundabout - 2 Lane with Median








Middle – Roundabouts - 3 Lane with Center Turn Lane

















Proposed 3-Lane Section with Center Turn Lane South of Matthews Road






South – Roundabouts - 3 lane with Center Turn Lane




















South End Survey








Speed Congestion Left Turns


















North – Middle – South Pedestrian Accommodation






PROPOSED MEDIAN DIVIDED 2-LANE SECTION MATTHEWS TO KRIF



PROPOSED MEDIAN DIVIDED 4-LANE SECTION NORTH OF KRIF


















North – Middle – South Pedestrian Accommodation





PROPOSED MEDIAN DIVIDED 4-LANE SECTION NORTH OF KRIF






PROPOSED MEDIAN DIVIDED 2-LANE SECTION MATTHEWS TO KRIF
